The 2008 Legislature passed Senate Bill 610 which was signed into law by Governor Crist on June 2, 2008. It included changes in State Statute as it relates to the Physical Education (P.E.) requirements for students in Florida. Senate Bill 610 was enacted to encourage students to become more physically active and to help students develop healthy lifestyles.

Students will choose three electives in addition to Physical Education (P.E.), in order of preference on their subject selection form. Of the four electives, each student will be given two electives based on allocation, one of which will be PE. If you choose for your child not to participate in PE, **you will need to sign at the bottom of this form.**
